### Up In Out

The balance of up in and out is what we are planning and hoping to maintain. At the Annual Church Meeting as Rector I shared a vision of a balanced life not just as individuals but also as a Church. It's now time to put our words into practice. On this Pentecost Sunday, it's a perfect time to look to God and ask for more of His Holy Spirit to come into our lives in order to equip us to look and go outward.

At the Annual Church Meeting, the tone was set to spend time as a Church in these three areas of balance : Up: intimate with God - Prayer; In: fellowship with each other & Out: sharing with those who are not Christians, sharing what we know which is the Good news that Jesus brings.

Pentecost is the birthday of the church, the time that the Holy Spirit came in power and did marvellous works to people who were open to him. It is important to note that prior to the Holy Spirit coming, the people were waiting and praying as Jesus had asked them. As "One Church in 3 locations" we need the Holy Spirit's power if we are going to have the balance of Up In and especially Out. We must start with Up, looking to God in prayer. As a result I want to designate a period of prayer on the 5th & 6th June. Next more details will follow as how this will work across the parish - watch this space.
